- Alt Saxophon Es; Tenor Saxophon B; Flügelhorn 1 B; Flügelhorn 2 B; Bassflügelhorn C; Euphonium:** Play a melodic line throughout the piece, starting in measure 1.
- Bässe:** Play a rhythmic pattern of eighth notes, starting in measure 1.
